X-RAY OF THE CHEST TWO VIEWS

INDICATION: Cough, fever and shortness of breath

TECHNIQUE: PA and lateral views of the chest are submitted for interpretation.

FINDINGS:

Pulmonary fields: There are no pulmonary infiltrates or nodules. Symmetrical aeration is noted.

Cardiac silhouette: Cardiac silhouette is within normal limits with a cardiothoracic ratio of 0.5, which is considered normal.

Mediastinum and hila: There is no mediastinal mass or evidence of mediastinal widening. The retrosternal space is well preserved with no opacities.

Osseous structures: Limited evaluation of the ribcage and thoracic spine reveals no abnormality.

Miscellaneous: There is no pneumothorax or pleural effusion. Costophrenic angles are clear bilaterally. There is no free air seen under the diaphragms.
